For quarter ended June 2021 the average HQLA of ₹1361.18cr. (as per the market value) comprises of ₹151.27cr in cash and remaining ₹1,209.91cr. from government securities and T Bill.

For the quarter ended June 30, 2021, data has been presented as simple averages of daily observations over the quarter. The company is complied with the LCR requirement for the quarter ended June 2021. The average LCR of the Company for the quarter ended June 30, 2021 was 67.96%.
